

Dear Neighbor:

We are writing to update you on the construction of the Bay Park Conveyance Project. The Bay Park Conveyance Project is a partnership between the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation and the Nassau County Department of Public Works. Western Bays Constructors (WBC) is the design-builder for this innovative Project.

The Project will convey treated water from the South Shore Water Reclamation Facility at Bay Park (formerly known as the Bay Park Sewage Treatment Plant) to the existing Cedar Creek Water Pollution Control Plant’s (WPCP) ocean outfall pipe, which discharges and diffuses treated water three miles offshore in the Atlantic Ocean. Construction involves underground microtunneling within your community. Microtunneling is a safe, effective way to install piping deep into the ground, avoiding long trenches and surface disturbance.

Bay Park Shaft 4 (BP4) is located on private property, off New Street in Oceanside. Bay Park Shaft 5 (BP5) is located at Oxbow Park, off Ocean Avenue near the East Rockaway LIRR Station. As

construction continues, we want to give you as much information as possible. Here's what you should know.

Construction Activity Update:

Microtunneling from BP5 to Bay Park Shaft 7 is now complete. Microtunneling activities at BP5 will resume shortly, where the microtunnel boring machine will tunnel south deep below the ground towards BP4. This microtunneling drive is expected to start in late June and continue through the month of July. Operations will take place seven (7) days a week for twenty-four (24) hours a day.

At BP4, crews will continue to prepare the shaft to receive the microtunnel boring machine. There will be a consistent presence of construction vehicles, equipment, and crews near both shaft sites. Crews will also be observed along the microtunneling drive to maintain geotechnical instrumentation installed to monitor the ground and structures during microtunneling.

Through a dedicated Community Outreach Program, WBC is committed to a robust engagement process and to maintaining an open line of communication throughout construction. We are also committed to minimizing disruption to neighborhoods affected by construction. WBC's Community Outreach Team is available to answer questions and acts as a project liaison throughout the duration of construction.
